

Matching


- Matching publication records with blacklisted journals was carried out in a hierarchical procedure.
 - 1. ISSN numbers
 - 2. Both journal title and publisher name identical to any of the blacklists.
 - 3. Manual matching of entries with matching journal titles using the DOI string had the identical structure as a matched publication.
- A total of 1800 published works in blacklisted journals were identified

Issues

- Controversial titles (e.g. Oncotarget: n=397, 156,7)
- Duplicates in publication databases
- Co-authored publications (Full/fractionalized counts)
- Final coverage: Journals turned problematic/hijacked
- Identifiers, DOI, ISSN, etc.


